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WORKSHOP OVERVIEW

PAPER SUBMISSION

All submissions should follow the IEEE 8.5" x 11" Two-Column Format. When using LaTeX, we recommend the following format options: `\documentclass [10pt, conference, compsocconf, letterpaper] {IEEEtran}`. If the paper is accepted for publication, up to 2 extra pages may be purchased for the camera-ready version. **Submitted papers can be of two types:**

- * Regular Research Papers: these papers should report original research results or significant case studies. They should be at most 8 pages.
- * Position Papers: these papers should report novel research directions or identify challenging problems. They should be at most 4 pages.
